The Transit system is operated by the City of Pocatello and provides rural services through Intergovernmental Agreements with county and municipal governments throughout Idaho Transportation District #5.

PUBLIC TRANSIT FOR ALL

All residents & visitors are eligible to ride. The welcome is extended to everyone to come & "TAKE YOUR SEAT" on the bus with Pocatello Regional Transit (PRT).

RURAL PRT SERVICES

Transit services being provided by PRT in Idaho Transportation District #5 have been greatly assisted by County and Municipal organizations, Idaho Transportation Department (ITD), Federal Transit Administration (FTA).
