FARES

Senior Citizens by Donations

<u>Note</u>: Senior Citizens 60 years & above, residing in Bear Lake County, are covered by a special fare because of the Title IIIB Support.

- \$2.00 <u>suggested donation</u>. One-way rides within and up to eight mile radius from Montpelier.
- \$8.00 <u>suggested donation</u>. One-way rides outside of the 8 mile area indicated above but still in Bear Lake County.
- \$4.00 plus \$1.00 per mile fare for all individual trips that leave Bear Lake County from the first mile. Contact PRT for information on this type of service.
- All services are based on PRT availability.

General Public (under 60 years), Students, and Persons with Disabilities (Under 60 years)

- \$2.00 for one-way rides within and up to eight mile radius of Montpelier.
- \$8.00 for one-way rides outside of the area indicated above but still in Bear Lake County. More than one ride per week is subscription, mileage rate then applies.
- \$4.00 plus \$1.00 per mile fare for all individual trips that leave Bear Lake County or the service area listed from the first mile. Contact PRT for information on this type of service.
- All services are based on PRT availability.
