Demand Response Service

Effective January 2025

PUBLIC TRANSIT FOR ALL

Residents and visitors within the service area are eligible to ride. The welcome is extended to everyone to come and "TAKE YOUR SEAT" on the bus with Pocatello Regional Transit (PRT).

ABOUT PRT

PRT's purpose is to provide seamless transportation throughout the rural areas of the seven counties of Idaho Transportation District #5. All the rides are demand-responsive.

The Transit system is operated by the City of Pocatello and provides rural services through intergovernmental agreements with county and municipal governments throughout Idaho Transportation District #5.

RURAL PRT SERVICES

Transit services being provided by PRT in Idaho Transportation District #5 have been greatly assisted by County and Municipal organizations, Idaho Transportation Department (ITD), Federal Transit Administration (FTA), and the Area Administration on Aging.

SERVICE INFORMATION

Applies to service in Grace, Soda Springs, and all areas in Caribou County.

- Hours of service based on reservations and demand from 8:00am to 5:00pm Monday through Friday. Service may vary and is subject to a minimum number of riders.
- Designated service to Pocatello is provided on the second Tuesday ONLY of each month. Contact PRT for more information.
- Any service (non-Medicaid) before 8:00 am or after 5:00 pm or services outside normal operating days requires PRT administrative approval.

RESERVATIONS

Call 208-234-2287 by 4:00 pm one business day in advance. When you call, please have your pick up and destination addresses ready so we can get you from point A to point B.



FARES

Senior Citizens by Donations

Note: Senior Citizens 60 years and above, residing in Caribou County, are covered by a special fare because of the Title IIIB Support.

- \$2.00 suggested donation. One-way rides within and up to eight mile radius from any of the communities of Grace and Soda Springs.
- \$8.00 suggested donation. One-way rides outside of the 8 mile area indicated above but still in Caribou County.
- \$10.00 suggested donation. One-way or round-trip ride for trips to Lava Hot Springs.
- \$12.00 suggested donation. One-way or round-trip ride for trips to Pocatello.
- \$4.00 plus \$1.00 per mile fare for all individual trips that leave Caribou County from the first mile. Contact PRT for information on this type of service.
- All services are based on PRT availability.

General Public (under 60 years), Students, and Persons with Disabilities (Under 60 years)

- \$2.00 for one-way rides within and up to eight mile radius of Grace and Soda Springs.
- \$8.00 for one-way rides outside of the area indicated above but still in Caribou County. More than one ride per week is subscription, mileage rate then applies.
- \$10.00 for one-way or round-trip ride for trips to Lava Hot Springs.
- \$12.00 for one-way or round-trip ride for trips to Pocatello.
- \$4.00 plus \$1.00 per mile fare for all individual trips that leave Caribou County from the first mile. Contact PRT for information on this type of service.
- All services are based on PRT availability.
